Eva E. (Lewis) Bramer, 98, of West Des Moines, formerly of Brooklyn, died Tuesday, Oct. 8, 2002, at Fountain West Health Care Center in West Des Moines.

A graveside service was Tuesday, Oct. 15, at Brooklyn Memorial Cemetery. The Rev. Dennis Smith of Madison Church of Christ officiated. Nevenhoven Funeral Services handled arrangements.
