

Last Services For Grant Inman Friday Afternoon

Funeral services conducted by Rev. W. F. Overhulser were held Friday afternoon at the James funeral home for Grant Inman, who passed away Wednesday in the Odd Fellows home in Mason City. He spent his early life on a farm near Deep River, before coming to Grinnell where he was a carpenter and building contractor for 55 years. He was an Odd Fellow for 46 years.

On March 1, 1891 he was united in marriage to Sarah Wadsworth. To this union were born 3 sons, Harlan R. of Grinnell, Silas W. of Grinnell and John R. of Los Angeles, Calif.

He was preceded in death by his wife Sarah, on Feb. 3, 1948. Also preceding him in death were 6 brothers and 5 sisters.

He leaves to mourn his passing, one sister, Metta Taylor, now living in Fremont, Nebr. Surviving grandchildren are Silas Inman, Jr., Mary Ellen Binegar, Mrs. Raymond Roth, Mrs. Harold Jones, Wilma Inman, Dorothy Inman, and Patty Lou Inman of Los Angeles, Calif.
