To this union were born three sons, Harlan and Elias of Grinnell and John of Los Angeles. Grant Mrs. Inman is survived by her sons, her husband, seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. One grandson, John, gave his life for his country during World War II.

Mrs. Inman was a member of the Grinnell Methodist church, having joined on profession of faith in 1916.
