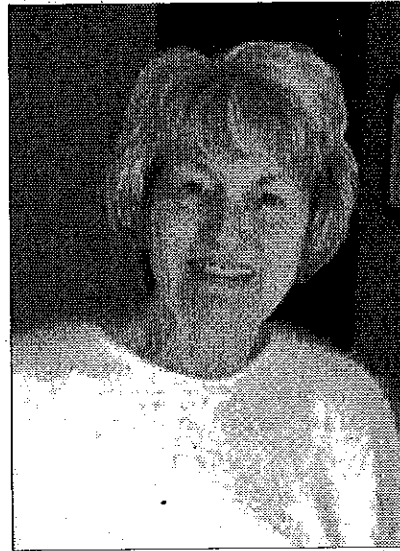


Daisy Frances Freeman
