



Ronald Reams. 68, of Montezuma, died Tuesday. May 27, 2008 at the Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines. Funeral services were held Saturday, May 31, at the Holland-Coble Funeral Home in

Montezuma. Interment was at the Pleasant Township Cemetery in Ewart.

Ronald James Reams, son of Ralph and Clara (Beeler) Reams was born July 15, 1939 in Grinnell. He attended Pleasant Township Country School and graduated from Montezuma High School in 1957.
