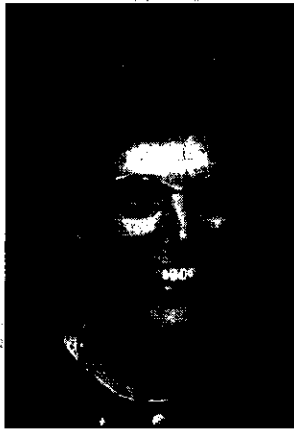


Release DONNA FAE WATSON 6-5-14
