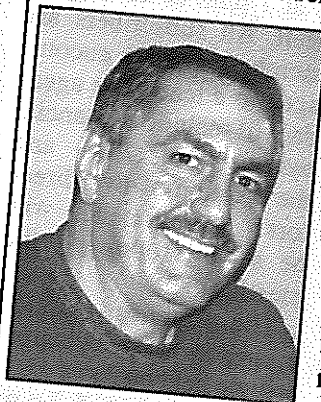


THOMAS WILLIAM NEOFOTIST
