Lois Lorraine Pickles, 78, of Kellogg, died Tuesday, June 21, at home.

Funeral services were Saturday, June 25, at Pence-Reese Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Larry Pauley of the Kellogg United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was at Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg.

She was born Sept. 15, 1927, in Kellogg to Mack Reed and Elsie Hasselbrink. She graduated from Kellogg High School and attended Central College. She was married to Joseph M. Pickles June 1, 1947, at United Methodist Church in Colfax. They lived in Kellogg and Rushville, northwest of Kellogg.
