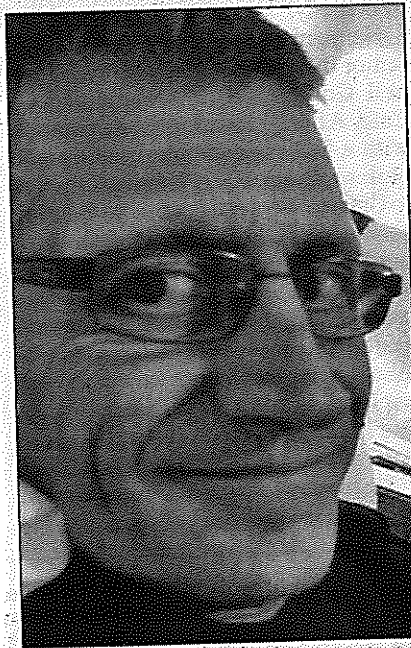


Bryan Eugene Pinnick
