DEATH OF LUCIA LEINS.

**Young Lady Passes Away at Home of
Parents in Marshalltown — Inter-
ment in Hazelwood.**

Mr. and Mrs. W. T. Leins of this city received a message Tuesday stating that their granddaughter, Miss Lucia Louise Leins, died at the home of her parents in Marshalltown from pneumonia, Tuesday at 1 p. m.

Miss Leins, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Leins, was born in Grinnell twenty-two years ago, and lived here until about four years ago, when the family moved to Marshalltown and engaged in the marble business. She attended the Grinnell schools, but left before her graduation and finished her schooling in Marshalltown.

The body was brought here yesterday, arriving at 10:15 a. m., and interment took place in the Hazelwood cemetery. Services at grave were in charge of Rev. J. M. Brown. A large number of old friends of the family and members of the Odd Fellows and Rebekah lodges met the funeral party at the train.
