Harold Oliver Berstler, age 100, of Millersburg, passed away Thursday, Dec. 6 at the English Valley Care Center in North English. Services were on Tuesday, Dec. 11 at the United Methodist Church in Millersburg, and burial followed at the Millersburg Cemetery with Military Honors.

Harold Oliver Berstler was born Sept. 3, 1918 in Dayton, the son of Samuel Berstler and Viola Mae Brawner Berstler. He was graduated from Millersburg High School in 1936 and proudly served in the U.S. Army Air Corp during World War II. Upon his return, Harold and Ruth King were united in marriage on May 21, 1948 in Washington. She passed away in 1981. On Apr. 29, 1995, he married Eulah Huff Mantz. Harold was a farmer for many years. He also ran a repair shop, and the Millersburg Skating Rink. He drove school bus for the Deep River Millersburg school district.
