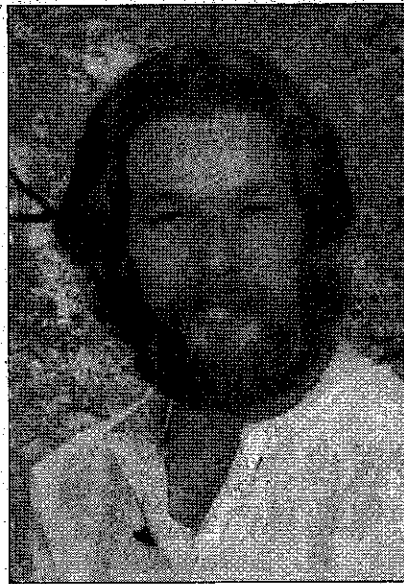
A graveside service with military honors will be held at 1 p.m. on Friday,
