Marjorie Hull, 101 of New Sharon passed away peacefully Friday afternoon, Oct. 4, at the Mahaska Health Partnership Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa. Funeral services will begin at 11:00 am Saturday, Oct. 12, at the Holland-Coble Funeral Home in New Sharon. Visitation will be open to the public from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm with the family not present and continue Saturday morning with the family one hour before the service. Burial will be in the Friends Cemetery in New Sharon. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to the New Sharon Fire and Rescue.

Marjorie Glenna Hull, the daughter of Lowell and Glenna (Moffitt) Hull, was born on Sept. 11, 1918 on the family farm two miles west of New Sharon. She attended Round Top Country School and was graduated from New Sharon High School in 1935 as the class salutatorian. She then attended business school in Des Moines and was employed there until her marriage to Raymond Hull on March 23, 1938. They began their life together working on a farm in Mahaska County. They enjoyed working together on farms in Mahaska County and in 1949 bought their own farm in Poweshiek County near Montezuma. After 35 years there, they retired to New Sharon.

Marjorie always enjoyed the outdoors, working with animals and gardening. Being in the kitchen, sewing, and reading were all favorite pastimes. Her

children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren were a continual source of joy.
