Russell was educated at Black Oak Country School and Lynnville High School. He lived and worked on the family farm until September 9, 1953, when he was enlisted into the U.S. Army. He served in the military for two years.

Following his discharge from the service on December 9, 1955, he purchased the sundries store in Lynnville and operated the store until 1962.
