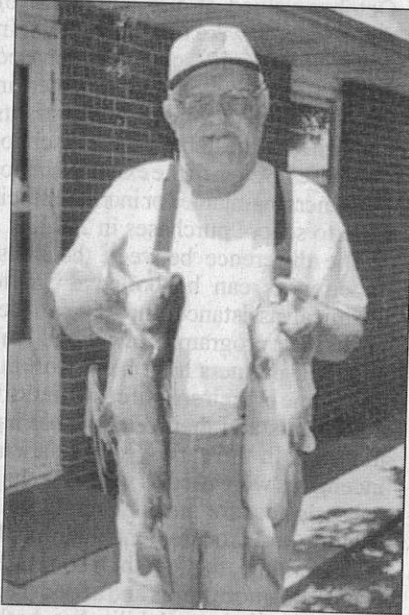


Virgil Leslie Thompson
