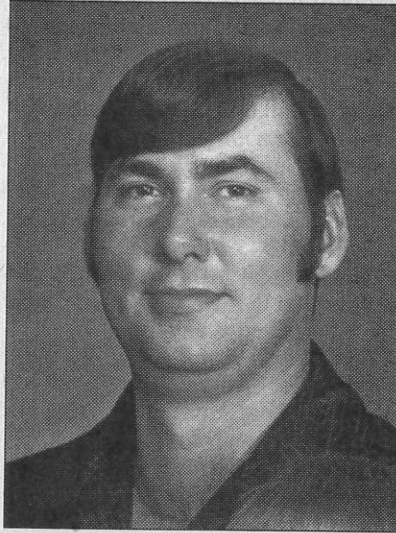


## Steve McClenathan
