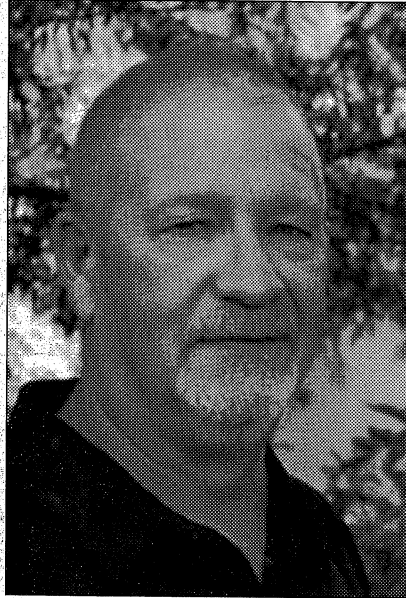

Kevin Kriegel



Kevin Kriegel, 58, of Brooklyn and formerly of Hartwick, died at his home on Jan. 19, 2023.

Kevin was united in marriage with Lisa Lea Koger on Aug. 31, 1985, at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Brooklyn. They had two sons and a daughter, and resided and farmed near Hartwick all of their married lives. Lisa died Nov. 6, 2017, after a battle with cancer.

He will be remembered for being a hard worker, for his fun-loving personality and sweet tooth, and for being able to fix nearly anything.
