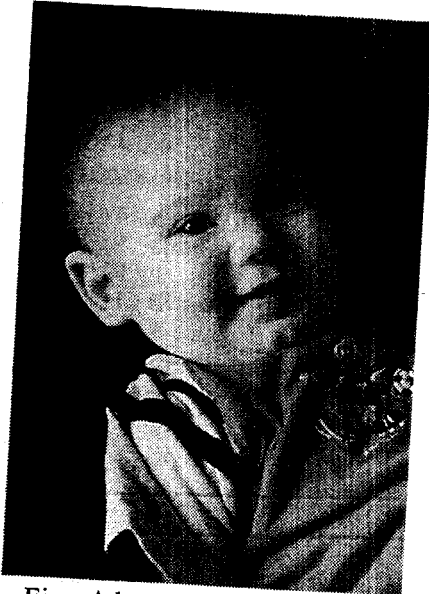
### **Eisac A. Kurk**
