Herbert L. Neuhaus, 81, of Victor, died on Thursday, May 31, 2007, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

A funeral service was held at 11:00 a.m., Monday, June 4, at St. James Lutheran Church in Victor with Rev. Thomas Shumaker officiating. Organist was Pam Cronbaugh and vocalists were Teri and Barbara Neuhaus. A private family burial will take place at a later date.
