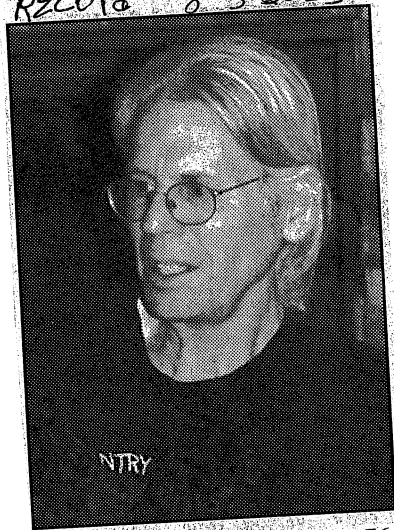


**TIMOTHY LAVERNE

Timothy Laverne Grier, 76, passed away June 26, 2023 at his home in Crow's Nest Pass, Alberta, CA. after struggling with Parkinson for 14 years.

He was born November 10, 1947 in Belle Plaine to Laverne and Margaret Joyce Grier. They later lived in Guernsey, Ladora, Belle Plaine, Deep River and Montezuma before moving to Canada.

Timothy was graduated from Montezuma High School in 1964. After guardian he attended Ellsworth Community College. Afterwards attending Illinois College of Optometry where he became an optometrist for the Boys' Club of Chicago.

On September 9, 1972 Tim was united in marriage to Barbara Brownold who he met in Chicago. Barbara had a Masters Degree in Nursing when they married.

The couple moved Alberta, CA where Tim had a dual citizenship. In Alberta they built a log cabin and later a log house which he expanded into an office for his optometry practice. Tim enjoyed the Rocky Mountains, camping, mountaineering, downhill and cross country skiing.

Retiring after 45 years as an optometrist Tim and Barbara moved to Crow's Nest Pass. After Tim was diagnose with Parkinson, his Iowa brothers Joel and Ted flew to Alberta to be with him.

Tim ashes were placed in Guernsey Cemetery on July 30 by his father's grave.

Tim spent time working on his ancestry and provided a Grier Family Memorial to the Guernsey Cemetery dedicated to his ancestor Thomas Grier.

He is survived by his mother Joyce, brothers Joel and Tim, sisters-in-law Jacki and Lois and 12 nephews and nieces.
