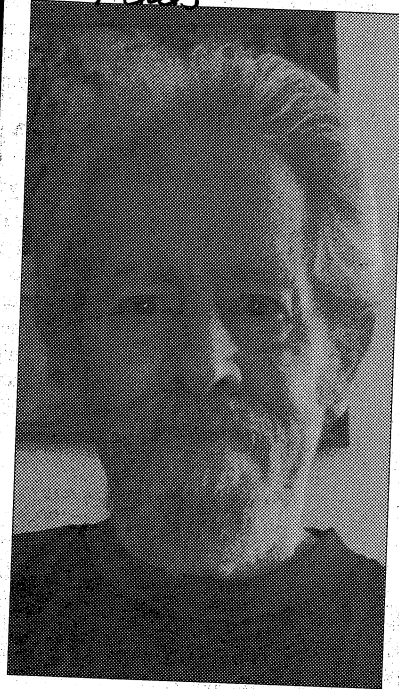

Carl William Paisley



Carl William Paisley, 70, of Albia, Iowa, passed away after a brief illness in his home on October 3, 2023.
