

MRS. AHRENS WAS BURIED TODAY

Former Resident of This City Passed
Away Yesterday Morning at the
University Hospital.

The funeral of the late Mrs. M. K. Ahrens was held this morning from the Hoheneschuh funeral parlors on Dubuque street at eleven o'clock conducted by the Rev. J. G. Hoerlein, pastor of the German Lutheran church in this city of which church deceased had long been a devoted member.

Mrs. Ahrens was nearly 74 years old and had come to this city about a month ago to submit to a surgical operation. She never fully recovered from the effects, death coming yesterday morning. Those who survive are three sons and one daughter, all married.

In 1893 Mr. Ahrens passed away at Grinnell and was buried at the Lutheran cemetery 4 miles south of Homestead. To this place the remains of Mrs. Ahrens were taken for interment, Rev. Hoerlein conducting the services at the grave also.

Mrs. Ahrens was a resident of this city from 1876 to 1884, but of late years has resided in Grinnell. One son, Rev. Frederick Ahrens passed away in Washington some time ago, his widow, who will be recalled as Emma K. Murschel, residing in this city.
