Floyd Airey, 67, Marshalltown, died Wednesday, July 1, in the emergency room at Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center of a heart attack.

Services were held Monday morning, July 6, at Estel-Perrin-Avey Funeral Home Chapel with the Rev. Ralph Symington officiating. Burial was in the Green Mountain Cemetery.
