Kenneth M. Allen, 32, of Audubon, Pa., died Tuesday, Nov. 27, at Temple University Hospital in Philadelphia, following a lengthy illness.

The son of Harry and Katherine Myers Allen, he was born Nov. 10, 1941, in Peoria, Ill. He later was graduated from Northwestern University and was a Rotary fellow while doing post-graduate work at Leeds, England.

On Aug. 21, 1966, he was married to Joye Barnes at Malcom. The couple had one daughter, Kendra, now 5.

Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Allen lived in Illinois, moving to Wisconsin in 1969. For the past two years they had made their home in Pennsylvania. Mr. Allen was associated with Colorcon, Inc., as a chemical engineer. He was a member of the Covenant Presbyterian Church in King of Prussia, Pa.

Survivors include his wife Joye; his daughter Kendra; his parents; his paternal grandparents; one brother, Roger Allen of Peoria, Ill.; a sister, Mrs. Carol Johnson of Oakwood, Ill.; and his mother-in-law, Mrs. Arlo (June) Barnes of Ames, formerly of Malcom.
