Harley Earl Amick, age 67, of 821 1/2 Broad Street, Grinnell, passed away suddenly Tuesday afternoon at Grinnell General Hospital of an apparent heart condition. Mr. Amick was the pastor of the Church of Christ church at 3rd and State street in Grinnell since last year. He was born in Howard County, Mo. on February 19, 1905, the son of Earl J. and Bertie Liggett Amick. Early in life he attended school in Fruitland, Idaho and was graduated from Fruitland High School in 1924.

Mr. Amick had entered the ministry in 1960 and had held several pastorates, among them Milwaukee, Wis. and Spur, Texas, before coming to Grinnell as an evangelist in June of 1971.
