Following the death of Mrs. Morrill several months ago Miss Andersen had made her home in Los Angeles.

Miss Andersen was born July 13, 1874, in St. Johnsbury, Vermont.

Miss Andersen had many friends, not only among townspeople of Grinnell but within the large list of alumni of the school, where she headed up the women's physical education for about 30 years.

For many years, while head of the physical education department for women, Miss Andersen staged the annual Colonial Ball at the time of Washington's birthday, February 22.

A nephew, Guy Morrill, is among the survivors. He resides at Santa Monica.

Funeral services for Miss Andersen were held this (Monday) morning from the Gates-Kingsley-Gates memorial home in Los Angeles, and burial was at Forest Lawn cemetery.
