Mrs. Anderson Rites Tuesday

Mrs. Christine Anderson, 79, widow of Christian Anderson died Saturday morning at St. Francis Manor, following an extended illness.

The daughter of Lars and Louise Larson, she was born Aug. 2, 1893, in Odense, Denmark. She attended school in Denmark and came to the United States in 1912. In 1916 she was married to Christian Anderson in Oshkosh, Wis. The couple had four children: Mrs. Clinton (Mary E) Moffitt of Grinnell; Mrs. Arthur (Vera L.) Krampe of Baxter, and a son and daughter who died in infancy.

Mr. and Mrs. Anderson moved to Iowa in 1923, and in 1936 they came to Grinnell. Mrs. Anderson worked for her nephew, Edward C. Anderson, in his plating shop during World War II and later was associated with C.W. DeLong and Sons jacket factory. She became a U.S. citizen in 1946. A member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Grinnell, she was also a member of Mary Martha Circle of the church and the National Federation of Grandmothers Club.

She is survived by her two

daughters: eight grandchildren, Eddie Chris, Paul, Betsy, and Evelyn Brown, all of Grinnell, and Randy, Connie, and Karen Krampe, all of Baxter; and her nephew, Edward C. Anderson of Grinnell. She was preceded in death by her husband, her infant son and daughter, and her parents.

Funeral services for Mrs. Anderson will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Marcus E. Reitz, pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, officiating. Music will be provided by Mrs. Willard Heffner, organist, and Betsy Brown and C. J. Moffitt, vocalists. Honorary flower-bearers will be the Grinnell National Federation of Grandmothers Club.
