Mrs. Anderson (GLENN) rites today

Helen Anderson, 92, of 408 Fifth Ave., Grinnell, died of a heart ailment Monday evening, June 27, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Philip J. Ramstad, pastor of the United Church of Christ — Congregational, officiating. Organist will be Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers will be Eldon Anderson, Gerald Arment, Gene Broders, Giles Jay, Maurice Neal and A.J. Schaefer. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery.

The daughter of Henry and Frances Balmest Schaefer, she was born Dec. 16, 1890, at Muscatine. She graduated from high school in Moline, Ill., in 1901 and later taught rural school near Wilton Junction.

One June 24, 1913, she was married to Glenn Anderson at Moline. The couple moved to Grinnell, where Mr. Anderson worked as a postal clerk for 48 years.
