Mrs. Anderson Native Here, Dies Friday

Mrs. Myrtle Anderson, native of Poweshiek county and resident of the Grinnell community most of her lifetime, died at a hospital at Des Moines on Friday, Nov. 26. She was 61 years old.

Funeral services were held this afternoon, Monday, from James Funeral Home with Rev. John DeLong, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating.

Daughter of George and Estella Chase, Mrs. Anderson was born in Poweshiek county, Dec. 21, 1892. She had lived in the Grinnell community until ten years ago when she moved to Des Moines following death of her husband, Fred J. Anderson.
