Robert Vernon Anderson, 74, of Newton, formerly of Grinnell, died of heart failure Thursday, July 16, at Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Newton, with the Rev. Ernest Bradia officiating. Burial was in Newton Union Cemetery, with the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
