

Kent Andrews dead at 72

Kent Andrews, 72, former Grinnell College faculty member died Sept. 11, according to word just received from Santa Barbara, Calif.

He was a member of the Grinnell faculty in speech and

dramatic art from 1943 to 1954, after five years of teaching at Coe College. He had been graduated from the University of Redlands in 1934 with a B.A. in speech and obtained an M.A. in drama from the University of Iowa in 1936.

In the early 1950's, he founded the Okoboji Summer Theatre and directed its activities for several years before leaving Grinnell to return to California in 1955, at which time operation of the theatre was taken over by Stephens College.

He and his wife, Van Earley Andrews, had four sons, David, Jock, Kim, and Todd.
