

## Funeral Rites for Charles Appleby, 88, Held Here Sunday

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Stella Stone of Grand Junction; and two sons, Reno B. of Vinton and Clarence. The latter lived with his father on the home place on No. 6 just west of the 6-63 junction. A brother, Andrew Appleby of Des Moines, also survives.

Appleby was preceded in death by his wife, Mary, in July of 1952, also four sisters and two brothers.
