

Rites held for Mr. Arvidson

Donald Arvidson, 58, died Wednesday, Nov. 8, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were held Nov. 10 at the Steffy Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Rev. John Darlington of the Montezuma Methodist Church officiating. Burial was at the Jackson Township Cemetery, with military rites conducted by American Legion Post 169 of Montezuma.

The son of Oscar and Gertrude Peterson Arvidson, he was born May 29, 1920, in Poweshiek County. He attended rural schools and worked on the farm. He was in the armed service from 1942

until 1944.

On Oct. 15, 1960, he was married to Garnette Fallis. They had lived in Poweshiek County the past 18 years where Mr. Arvidson was engaged in farming. He was a member of the Methodist Church, the Farm Bureau, and the American Legion.
