Mrs. Art Bachman Rites Held Wednesday

Mrs. Bachman, 77, passed away Monday, August 3, at Grinnell General Hospital.

The daughter of Sarah and Samuel Ingraham, she was born near Ferguson, Iowa, on Feb. 6, 1893. The family mo-

ved to Barnes City where she attended school.

On Thanksgiving Day, 1917, she married Mr. Bachman and to this union one son was born. Most of their married life has been spent in Montezuma where they operated a dry cleaning business.

She was a member of the Christian Church, the American Legion Auxiliary and the Gold Star Mothers.

She was preceded in death by her son, Edwin, who was shot down over Germany during World War II.
