

Hattie Bacon Rites Saturday (ALBERT)

Hattie C. Bacon, 97, a resident of Grinnell for many years, died Tuesday evening (May 8) at St. Francis Manor, following an extended illness.

The daughter of Thomas C. and Elizabeth Pilgrim, she was born Aug. 17, 1875 at Rock Island, Ill. At the age of eight, she moved with her parents to Grinnell and received her education in the Grinnell schools.

On June 7, 1905, she was married to Albert H. Bacon at her parents' home. Following their marriage, they farmed in the Chester community for some time, then moved into Grinnell where she had made her home until October of 1970 when she went to Cedar Rapids to live with her son Donald. She had been a patient in St. Francis Manor since May 3. Mrs. Bacon was a member of the United Church of Christ—Congregational for over 50 years.

She is survived by her two sons, Donald of Cedar Rapids and Harold of Yucaipa, Calif.; a granddaughter, Mrs. Joe (Judy) Lloyd of Puerto Rico; a grandson, Hal of Yucaipa, Calif.; two great-grandchildren, Jody Kimberly and Joanna Lloyd; and her nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, two sisters, and two brothers.

Funeral services for Mrs. Bacon will be held at 1:30 p.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home, with the Rev. Ralph Beebe officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery.
