

William Bader Funeral Rites Set for Tuesday

Funeral services will be held this Tuesday at 2 p.m. at the James funeral home for William Bader, 67, former Grinnell resident who died Saturday morning of a stroke at his home in Huxley, Iowa.

The Rev. Leland Mann will officiate. The body will be cremated.

Survivors include his wife, Nina, two sons, Raymond of Skokie, Ill., and Lester of Festus, Mo.; two daughters, Gladys Bader of Huxley and Mrs. John (Madeline) Slattery Palo Alto, Calif.; one brother and two sisters. He was preceded in death by one daughter and one son.

Born Aug. 5, 1889 in New York City, he came to Iowa in 1912. He was married Jan. 24, 1914 to Nina Hoskin at Grinnell. From 1914 until 1942 he was a florist in Grinnell.
