Edna L. Badger, 75, of Rte. 1, Grinnell, died of a heart attack at here home Saturday morning, June 5.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at St. John's Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Marcus Reitz, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery. Memorials in Mrs. Badger's name may be made to the church.
