

Harley Badger rites Aug. 9

Harley Badger, 53, of Gilroy, Calif., formerly of Grinnell, died of a heart attack Aug. 6 at Gilroy.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday, Aug. 9, at the Haven Funeral Home, with burial at Gilroy.
