Anna J. Bahrenfuse, 77, of Rte. 1, Grinnell, the wife of Frank H. Bahrenfuse, died Sunday, Feb. 3, at Grinnell General Hospital.

The daughter of Thomas and Mary Ann Young Prosser, she was born Dec. 3, 1897, in Des Moines. She began her education in the Des Moines schools. When she was 8, her father died, and she made her home with Mr. and Mrs. Frank Watson, her aunt and uncle. She continued her education in the rural schools south of Grinnell.

On Oct. 16, 1918, she was married to Frank H. Bahrenfuse at the Methodist parsonage in Montezuma, and since their marriage they had farmed southwest of Grinnell. Mrs. Bahrenfuse was a member of the Westfield Grange.
