

## Elizabeth Bailey services held

Elizabeth Bailey, 88, of St. Francis Manor died Wednesday evening, Oct. 15, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home, with Ray Standerwick, pastor of the Oak Grove Friends Church, officiating.
