James H. Baldrey, 76, 1107 Fourth Ave., formerly of Troy, N. Y., died Monday, June 5, at Grinnell General Hospital of a heart condition. Mr. Baldrey had made his home in Grinnell since last summer to be near his family.

Services will be Friday, June 9, at 1:30 p. m. at First United Presbyterian Church, Troy, with burial in Memory Garden Cemetery, Colony, N. Y. Memorials in his name may be left at Smith Funeral Home.
