**JANE STEWART BASSETT.**

Jane Stewart Bassett was born July 7, 1849, at Williamsport, Pa., and ended this life June 9, 1921, at Sterling, Ill., at the age of 71 years, 3 months and 2 days. She is to rest in Union cemetery at Rock, Iowa, beside her former husband, Charles H. Stewart, a veteran of the Civil War, who died in 1897. She was married to her second husband, Marquis Bassett, in 1907, at Iowa City, Iowa.
