Services Sunday For Harvey Bates In Gilman Church

Funeral services were held yesterday for Harvey James Bates, 47, who died early Thursday morning at University hospitals, Iowa City.

Bates lived northwest of Newburg in Hickory Grove Township, Jasper County. Since October 1958, he had been employed by the conservation commission at Rock Creek Lake State Park. He was hospitalized since Aug. 19.

Bates was born the son of James Helmn and Effie Deana Bates near Lamaille in Marshall County, on Dec. 12, 1911. He received his education in the Conrad public schools. On Jan. 2, 1937, he was married to Iola Orena Phelps in Parkersburg. He had three children, all surviving.

The children are Charles Bates of Knoxville, Carol Ann and Dean Harvey, both of the family home. Bates is also survived by his wife, two grandchildren and one sister, Mrs. Ethel Nason of Conrad.

The services were held at the Gilman Methodist church with the Rev. Norman Kauble officiating. Burial was in Hickory Grove Cemetery. Pallbearers were Thomas Clark, Lee Houser, Harold Palmer, Wendell Paul, Frank Patterson and Raymond Wallis.

Others participating in the services were flower bearers Mrs. Thomas Clark and Mrs. Ethel Gillespie, organist Mrs. Edythe Harbit and two vocalists, Mrs. Dale Locker and William Viseman, Jr.
