Last Rites Said For Sarah Bates

Mrs. William John (Sarah Jane) Bates, 78, a resident of the Kellogg community since 1921, died at her home on Rte. 2 Monday.

The daughter of John and Elizabeth Jane Johnson Beggs, Mrs. Bates was born March 14, 1890, in North Ireland where she received her education.

Mrs. Bates was married to William John Bates on March 4, 1914, in North Ireland. That same year they moved to Laurel and lived there until moving to Kellogg in 1921. Her husband preceded her in death in 1932.

Funeral services for Mrs. Bates were held at 2 p.m. today (Thursday) in the Johnson Chapel with

the Rev. Robert Gamble, minister of the Kellogg Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in Grace and Cemetery in Laurel.

Survivors include two sons — Warren and Elmer of Kellogg; three sisters and a brother in Anrim, North Ireland; two granddaughters — Mrs. Robert Dewar and Mrs. Larry Wood of Newton; five great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews in Ireland.
