Funeral Services for J. Meyer Baderstadt

J. Meyer Baderstadt passed away at the home of his sister, Mrs. W. Sleight, 1511 Washington, Ave., Cedar Rapids, Iowa, at the age of 66 years and 4 months; he had been in ill health for some time.
