Harold A. Beck, 61, Omaha, Neb., formerly of Malcom, died of a massive heart attack Monday, June 11, at work.

Funeral services will be held Friday, June 15 at 11 a. m. at Crosby Kunold Burket Funeral Home in Omaha.

He was born June 29, 1928, in Grinnell, the son of Karl and Mary Beck of Malcom. He attended rural schools and Malcom High School and on June 19, 1949, was married in Malcom to Ann Lee.
