

## Plan Wednesday Funeral Rites For John Beck

Funeral Services for John George Beck, 74, Rte. 4, who died Saturday morning at a local hospital following an illness of two months, will be held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Smith Funeral Home.

Officiating will be the Rev. F. J. Peters, pastor of the Trinity Lutheran church. Organ music will be provided by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers will be Fred Beck, Richard Beck, Walter Beck, Raymond Beck, Carl Rohr and Loring Rohr.

Interment will be in Trinity Lutheran cemetery.

Mr. Beck was born Sept. 3, 1885, in Brettach, Wuttenburg, Germany, and was the eldest son of Louis and Katherine Heinle Beck. He received his early education in Germany and in May of 1889 came to this country.

He was employed as a carpenter and mason.

Mr. Beck was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church and had belonged to the Eagles lodge.

Survivors include one sister and two brothers: Mrs. Rosa Rohr of near Grinnell, George Beck of Clear Lake, Minn., and Herman Beck of Grinnell. He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers.
