

George Bell dies in Colorado

George Lincoln Bell, 72, formerly of the Grinnell-Newburg area, died Saturday, Oct. 3, of a heart attack at Los Animas, Colo.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at Byron Griffy Funeral Chapel.
