

Services Held In Brooklyn Saturday For Harry Bickford

Funeral services were held from a Brooklyn funeral home Saturday for Harry Elsworth Bickford of Brooklyn who died at a local hospital last Tuesday.

Rev. Clare Shupe, of the Brooklyn Methodist church, officiated at the services. Burial was in the I.O.O.F. cemetery in Brooklyn.

Bickford was born Sept. 18, 1881 in Sheldon, Mo. and came to Iowa when he was 21 years old. He had made his home near Brooklyn since that time. During the same year, he became a member of the Madison Christian Church, of which he was a member until his death.

On Feb. 18, 1914, he was united in marriage to Ella Boyle of Hartwick. They moved to Brooklyn immediately after their marriage and have made their home there since that time.

He was a member of the I.O.O.F. lodge of Brooklyn and of the Deborah Rebecca lodge No. 202.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and
