

## Last Rites Tuesday For Eugene Block

Funeral services for Eugene F. Block, 75, who formerly lived near Hartwick, were held Tuesday at the McAninch chapel in Victor. Rev. Robert Cutbirth officiated at the two o'clock service. Organist was Mrs. Louise Kornis.

Interment was in the Hartwick cemetery with the following serving as pallbearers: Milo Leimberer, Cliff Williamson, Harlan Wessell, Clement Wauters, Rayman Smith and Ward Fearneyhough.

The eldest son of Ferdinand and Amelia Block, he was born January 20, 1892, near Hartwick. He was a member of the Church of Christ and attended rural schools in the Hartwick community.

Mr. Block farmed near Hartwick until entering World War I Feb. 22, 1918. He returned

honorable discharge March 8, 1919. For the past five years he had been a patient in Veterans' hospital at Knoxville where he died Sunday, April 9, 1967.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Alma Rupp of Hogkins, Ill., five nephews and one niece. Preceding him in death were his parents, a sister and a brother.
